WHAT IS LEARNING LIFE?

Classroom & campus therapy animal visits to reduce stress, improve social-emotional skills, teach healthy behavior, & offer comfort. Our animals also provide crisis support as part of the Bellingham Mobile Response Team.

WHY ANIMALS?

- Petting fur releases serotonin, oxytocin
- Promotes improved focus and relationships
- Animals accept us & promote self-esteem
- Animals teach empathy, clear and kind communication, and emotional awareness

FOR GRADES K-5

1-hour classroom visits with customizable curriculum. Therapy animals teach about empathy, emotional awareness, healthy relationships and coping skills.

FOR GRADES 6-12

Animals support students through final exams or times of increased stress. Visits may be during lunch hour with grade levels, or with classrooms.

FOR SMALL GROUPS

School counselors or teachers may reach out to provide individualized support to students in need.

Curriculum is created following consultation with teacher or school counselor and can be personalized to fit particular needs.
